



Each season lasts for <u>three</u> months, with summer being the <u>warmest</u>, and winter the coolest.














PUMPKIN MATH








ACORN ALPHABET

Practice writing your lower case letters on the acorns below. When finished color the empty acorns so that Mr. Squirrel can easily find them!








Fall Leaves
