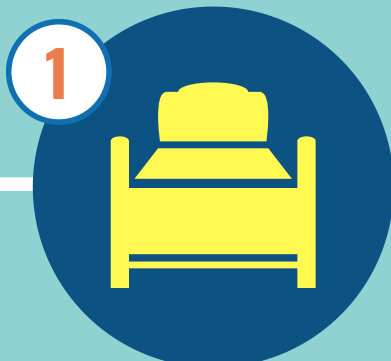


GET A *Debt - free* COLLEGE EDUCATION
